ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Swadeshi Educational and Welfare Trust, Vill-G-115, Street/Road-Pushkar Enclave, Taluka/Mandal-Paschim Vihar, Town/City-Delhi, Dist-Delhi, Delhi-110063 has applied for grant of recognition to **Swadeshi College of Education, Vill:- 5(P), Street/Road-G.C. Maranga, Taluka/Mandal-Purnia, Town/City-5(P), Dist-Purnia, Bihar-854301 (Code No.ERCAPP201646225) (ID. No.10937)** for B.Ed. Course online 29.06.2015 for two year duration and hard copy received by Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE on 11.07.2015.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 239th meeting held on 28th April-02nd May, 2017 considered the matter and as decided, formal permission order under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 for B.Ed. programme with an total intake of 150 (Three basic units) from the academic session 2017-2018 vide Order F.No.ERC-239.6.123(Part-4)/ B.Ed. (Addl. Intake)/ 2017/ 52986 dt.02.05.2017.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 290th meeting held on 03rd March, 2021 considered the original file alongwith other related documents submitted by the institution, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the order dated 16.02.2021 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) No.2046/2021 and decided to grant permission for B.Ed. course of one additional unit (50 intake) under Clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 from the academic session 2021-2022, thus making the total intake of 200 (four units).

4. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants permission to **Swadeshi College of Education, Vill-5(P), Street/Road-G.C. Maranga, Taluka/Mandal-Purnia, Town/City-5(P), Dist-Purnia, Bihar-854301** for conducting B.Ed. Course of two years duration with an additional intake of **50 (existing 150 intake + additional 50 intake), thus making the total intake of 200 (four basic units)** from the academic session **2021-2022** under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs.7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

5. Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

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6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
7. The institution shall maintain its website with hyperlink to the Council and the Eastern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website, namely:-
- Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
 - Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
 - Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - Fee charged from students;
 - Available infrastructural facilities;
 - Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to, and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application;
 - The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - Any false or incomplete information on its website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
8. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
9. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.
10. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD
11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition / permission by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
